Introduction

Early Start wants to assist & encourage all parents enrolled with Early Start to be 'legal drivers'. This means driving with a Licence in a registered & warranted vehicle.



What the Funded Driver Licence Programme is Offering:

Assistance for you to attain your Learner's or Restricted Licence

Funding of classroom lessons, driving lessons and Licence fees *(a professional driving instructor will take these lessons)*

What Your Family Support Worker Will Do:

She will discuss the Programme with you to see if you wish to participate and if you meet the criteria

If you wish to participate she will ask you to complete an application form which she will discuss with her supervisor

If your application is successful she will offer you a place on the Programme & discuss the Agreement with you

The Agreement will be signed by you and your FSW *(Early Start will retain the original and give you a photocopy)*

She will then need to sight the vehicle you will use for practice to confirm & record the registration and Warrant of Fitness details
